TITLE OF BILL:

An act to amend part FFF of chapter 59 of the laws of 2018, amending the public health law relating to authorizing the commissioner of health to redeploy excess reserves of certain not-for-profit managed care organizations, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

PURPOSE:

To extend various provisions of the public health law related to authorizing the Commissioner of Health to obtain all financial and other records deemed necessary to evaluate an Health Maintenance Organization's reserves

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS:

Section 1: Extends section 2 of subpart B of part FFF of Chapter 59 of the laws of 2018, which relates to authorizing the commissioner of health to redeploy excess reserves of certain non-profit managed care organizations until August 1, 2025.

Section 2: Effective date

JUSTIFICATION:

This bill is necessary to ensure the continuation of specific laws of critical importance to the Commissioner of Health relating to not-for-profit managed care organizations in order to avoid the expiration of those laws. Through these sections, the Commissioner is able to check the organization's reserves and ensure that they are in operating order and authorizes the Commissioner to make regulations related to an organizations reserves.
